PERSONALITY DEVELOPMENT CAMP-2022

AIM

The aim of the camp is to inculcate discipline, qualities of leadership, team spirit and camaraderie under field conditions into younger generation with a view to help him/her to attain an all round personality.



AGE LIMIT, PHYSICAL STANDARDS

Age should be between 10 years and upto 16 years. Students should be physically and medically fit.

FEES

The cost of form and camp fees is Rs. 200/- and Rs. 7906/- per student respectively inclusive of GST. The fees includes lodging, boarding and training. It should be remitted by cash or DD in favour of Bhonsala Adventure and Sports Foundation, Nagpur drawn on any nationalized bank payable at Nagpur. Name of the applicant must be endorsed in BLOCK LETTERS on the reverse of the draft. Cheques will NOT be accepted.

NO REFUND OF FEES IS ADMISSIBLE AFTER CONFIRMATION OF VACANCY ON ANY GROUNDS INCLUDING MEDICAL.

LOCATION

The camp is held at Bhonsala Military School, "Panchawati", Village Chakki Khapa, Near Godhani Rly. Stn., Koradi

Road, Nagpur. It is approximately 14 kms from Nagpur.

ACCOMMODATION & MESSING

Centrally air cooled dormitories, mattress & pillow will be provided. Nutritious vegetarian food will be served everyday during breakfast, lunch and dinner. Hot milk will be served twice a day. Food will be provided as per pre-decided menu. No complaints on this account will be entertained. Outside food is not permitted, except dry fruits and biscuits.

LAUNDRY AND BARBER FACILITY

Laundry and barber facility, less dry cleaning will be available at the camp premises; charges of which are included in course fee. (Condition Apply)

PERSONAL CLOTHING & ARTICLES

Every trainee must bring personal clothing and toiletries as per own requirement in a suitcase with locking arrangement.

TRAINING

The training programme is structured to inculcate qualities of leadership, spirit of national integration and character building in adolescent stage. The course is not aimed at making the camper, a well trained soldier / rider / swimmer / shooter but to give an experience of these activities in available time frame.



The training programme will cover the basic skills in the following :-

- Physical Training • Firing • Swimming
- Horse Riding • Archery • Obstacle Training • Rock Climbing & Rappelling
- Map Reading • Self Defence
- Yoga • Moral Education • Group Discussion • Night Navigation • Basic Boxing Skills • Sports & Games
- Interesting Guest Lectures

DISCIPLINE

One of the main objective of the camp is to inculcate discipline in children. Thus a strict discipline is enforced throughout the duration of the camp. No fancy hair styles are permitted for boys. All boys will be subjected to short hair cuts as per military standards. Non compliance to routine of the camp or instructions or any act of breach of discipline may entail withdrawal of trainee from the camp, without assigning any reason.

FOR ATTENTION OF PARENTS

The training is on a camp mode which is strenuous and involves a lot of outdoor activities. The campers are susceptible to injuries despite mandatory safety precautions. The authorities shall thus not be held responsible for any untoward incident. Shoes bites are also common during training. It is therefore desirable to come for the camp with canvas/sports shoes, that they are used to. Parents are requested to educate their wards to follow appropriate COVID protocol.

INSTRUCTIONS

- Trainee once admitted will not be allowed to leave the camp premises without written request from parents or local guardian. Such request from a trainee will not be entertained.
- The camp authorities will not be responsible in case a trainee absconds from the camp. Intimation of such cases will be given to parents through possible communication channels.

- Responsibility to collect left behind baggage solely rests with the parents.
- Valuable articles and cash are not permitted. The camp authorities shall not be held responsible in case of loss or theft.
- Electronic gadgets such as transistors, iPods, mobile phones, laptops, cameras, etc. are not permitted. If found, they will be confiscated and not returned back to the camper or the parents.
- No one is permitted to visit the camp or meet the campers. No message or telephone call for campers will be entertained. Campers are also not allowed to use school telephone.

ARRIVAL AND REPORTING

Campers must bring their identity cards issued during registration at the time of reporting and present the same at the Reporting Centre.

Reporting time is at 9 AM sharp.
